Old proforma designs given a limited life extension

Waka Kotahi's Don Hutchinson, Principal Engineer – Heavy Vehicles, has advised that the old proforma designs that were to be discontinued from 1 December 2021 have now been given an extended expiry date to 31 March 2022.

This approach will assist the issue of parts delay etc. from Covid-19, for trailers in build and provide a bit more time to finish the new proforma for the short wheelbase truck towing a short wheelbase trailer (as requested by TTMF & MIA).

This decision may be reviewed again if necessary.
