TRANSMISSION GULLY SH1 ACCESS FOR 50MAX AND HPMV

The following advice regarding Transmission Gully access for HPMV and other vehicles was released by Waka Kotahi's Manager, permitting Riccardo Areosa on 28 March 2022 :

“With the imminent opening of Transmission Gully, permitted access will be available to 50MAX, HPMV permit holders once the road is officially opened.

*“Overweight permit holders please continue to use SH59 supported by the attached addendum unless you hold an OW permit issued this year (2022) ie. your permit number ends with **WN/C/22**.*

*“Overweight permit holders need to apply for a new Wellington network permit after **April 4th** to be able to use the road unless they hold a OW permit issued this year (2022) for the region.*

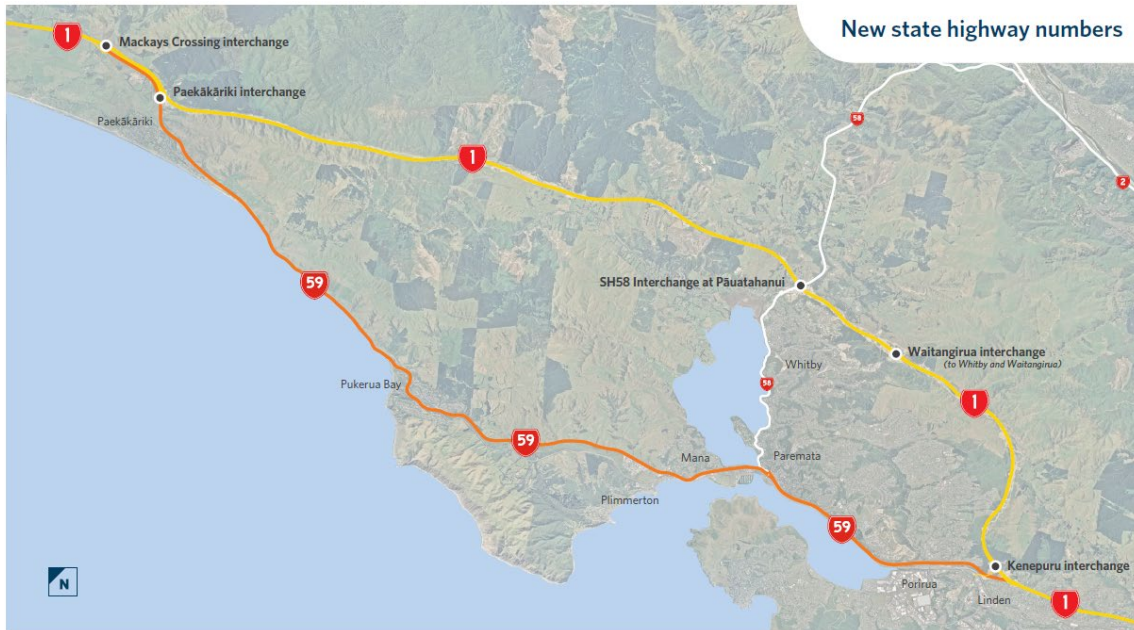

Addendum for HPMV, Overweight, and 50MAX Permits

This addendum applies to all current HPMV, Overweight and 50Max permits to cover the renumbering of SH1N between Linden and Mackays Crossing, which took effect 7th December 2021.

This section was renamed as **SH59**, as part of a wider project to prepare the State Highway network and road users for changes to the network when the new Transmission Gully motorway opens.

Vehicles with a current NZTA issued HPMV, Overweight, or 50Max permit are permitted to continue to use this renumbered route, under the same conditions as the existing permits.



The new Transmission Gully SH1 road is to open at the end of March, go to [Transmission Gully Motorway](#) for general information

How will this affect permit holders?

1. All HPMV and 50MAX permit holders can use the Transmission Gully motorway under existing permits.
2. Overweight permit holders who have a permit issued during 2022, i.e., the permit number begins with WN/C/22 can use the new Transmission Gully motorway.
3. Overweight permit holders who have a permit issued before 2022, i.e., the permit number begins with WN/C/20, or WN/C/21 will need to apply for a new Wellington network permit **after April 4th** to be able to use the road.
